Good morning,

The nomination period for the FLEOHOF has opened and FPCA will be taking applications through COB on August 8th. All nominations must be received by the FPCA Executive Director by this time and will then be reviewed by the Awards Committee and the Board of Directors. The timeframe is critical as the Awards Committee and the Board need time to review and vote on final nominations in order for a package to be provided to FDLE by the deadline of August 31st. No nominations received after August 8th will be considered.

The nomination form along with letters of support and an electronic agency/department photo must be submitted by August 8th to [jpritt@fpca.com](mailto:jpritt@fpca.com). Please ensure that the checklist of requirements on the form is met before submitting to FPCA.

#### 11D-10.001 Eligibility Requirements.

- (1) Any person nominated for induction into the Florida Law Enforcement Officers' Hall of Fame shall meet the following minimum eligibility requirements:
  - (a) An active, retired, or deceased Florida law enforcement officer as defined in Section 943.10(1), F.S.;
  - (b) Born in Florida or adopted Florida as their home state pursuant to Section 222.17, F.S.;
  - (c) Served in the field of law enforcement in the State of Florida;
  - (d) Exhibited excellent character within the line of duty and to the community for which he/she served. For the purpose of this rule, the term excellent character means the officer has exhibited good moral character pursuant to Rule 11B-27.0011, F.A.C.; and,
  - (e) Be of good reputation among peers and in the community served.
- (2) Governor's Office employees, state elected officials, and members of the Florida Law Enforcement Officers' Hall of Fame Selection Committee are ineligible

for induction until two years after they have left their position.
