QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

Preferred candidate must:

- Be 21 years of age or older
- Have high school diploma or equivalent, and completed basic police officer training academy
- Have U.S. citizenship
- Be able to pass a medical examination
- Be able to pass a thorough background check
- Possess a valid Florida driver's license or be able to obtain one prior to employment

Necessary Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Demonstrated ability to perform work requiring little supervision
- Good physical condition
- Sound conflict resolution skills
- Sound oral and written communication skills
- Technical competence with computers

Benefits:
